Professor Cosimo Sperti is a member of the pancreatic surgical team at the 3rd Surgical Clinic, Department of Surgery, Oncology and Gastroenterology, University of Padua, Padua, Italy. After receiving his medical degree from the University of Padua in 1979, he took post-graduate degree in general Surgery (1984) and Oncology (1987) at the University of Padua. He was appointed as Associate Professor of Surgery (2014-present) at the University of Padua. Prof. Sperti has a strong research and clinical interest in pancreatic cancer and hepatobiliary malignancies. He is involved in testing innovative technology in diagnosing and staging pancreatic tumors, pancreatic cystic neoplasms, in evaluating results of surgical treatment and follow-up of patients with pancreatic cancer.

Publications and presentations: 129 full, peer-reviewed publications, 25 book chapters, 533 presentations at international or national meetings.
